

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19
CITY OF STANLEY, IDAHO**

A PUBLIC HEARING, PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE 50-1002 will be held for consideration of the proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and running through September 30, 2019. The hearing will be held at the Stanley Community Building, 510 Eva Falls Avenue, Stanley, Idaho, on **Thursday, August 30, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.** All interested persons are invited to appear and show cause, if any, why such budget should or should not be adopted. Please note that the figures below are including grant funds. Detailed copies of the proposed City Budget are available at City Hall during regular office hours (8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday thru Thursday). City Hall is accessible to persons with disabilities. Anyone desiring accommodations for disabilities in order to allow access to the budget documents or to the hearing should contact the Stanley City Office at 208-774-2286 at least 48 hours prior to the public hearing.
