Race Info: * - **Denotes a two-day event.** Mileage split between Saturday and Sunday (i.e. 20, 40, 60 total mileage/10, 20, 30 miles per heat/per day).

Friday, March 9

5:00pm - Veterinarian Check of dogs begins.

7:00pm - Mushers Meeting at Mountain Village Restaurant (turn in applications and fees). Prime rib dinner will be provided free to mushers.

Saturday, March 10 - Start times may vary slightly

8:00am - Pre-race Mushers Meeting and Volunteer Meeting at Mountain Village Restaurant. Breakfast available.

10:00am - Race start for 1st heat - *20 (4-6 dog), *40 (6-8 dog), *60 (10-12 dog) mile races.

12:00pm to 2:00pm - Teams arrive at finish line.

2:00pm - Skijoring race start: Advanced 4 mile (1-2 dog) Novice 2 mile (1-2 dog).

Sunday, March 11

9:00am - Race start for 2nd heat - *20, *40, *60 mile races. Reverse start order - slowest teams first.

10:00am to 12:00pm - Teams arrive at finish line.

1:30pm - Awards presentation. Location TBD.
