

City of Stanley Work Session Minutes June 3, 2021

IN ATTENDANCE FOR THE CITY:

Mayor Steve Botti, Council President Laurii Gadwa, Councilmember Tim Cron, Councilmember Austin Clegg. Councilmember Cardoso arrived at 9:20 a.m. City staff members included: City Clerk/Treasurer Cari Tassano.

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Botti called the meeting to order @ 9:08 a.m.

CUSTER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION:

Jolie Turek with Custer Economic Development Association has been working with the mayor on a couple of grant projects, including the Gem Grant that we have been rewarded. Now they are working with the Development Company on a grant for Stanley Pioneer Park. Thirdly, she is working with 3 different housing/building companies: LEAP housing, The Housing Company and NW Housing Company (all local companies). She updated the City Council on these processes. The Council thanked Jolie for all her hard work.

IDAHO DARK SKY ALLIANCE:

Carol Cole with the Idaho Dark Sky Alliance is requesting an \$1,800 allocation in the FY 2022 Budget for the Central Idaho Dark Sky Reserve. Jeffrey Hall suggested a possible match for a grant the Chamber of Commerce is applying for the Dark Sky Reserve, this grant could be up to \$2,000. The City Council budgeted another \$2,000 for this grant but will need more information prior to giving final approval.

FY21-2022 BUDGET:

The City Council went through each line item in the General Fund Expenses.

The City Council Returned at 10:57

The Council picked up at Winter Event Expenses in the general fun and continued to go through each line item. Some of the highlights were \$1,200.00 for two blinking speed limit signs, \$100,000 for Grant matches in Pioneer Park Fund. The City Council decided that they would be willing to expend 75% of the option tax reserve money on a large park project. Professional services line items were added to both street & Road and the Park fund for any professional services needed.

EMPLOYEE HOUSING TRAILER FOR JEREMY BOSWELL (White Cloud Rafting) AT 535 ACE OF DIAMONDS: Councilmember Cron moves to approve the employee housing trailer contingent on the sewer connection being completed and paid for. Councilmember Cardoso seconds. All approve. Motion passes.
