CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Botti called the meeting to order @ 9:15 a.m.

SALMON RIVER CLINIC:

Amy Klinger would like the City of Stanley to take over their 1/3 cost of the 911 Cost Share between us, the clinic and Sawtooth Rural Fire Department. She expressed that their budget is greatly impacted with all of the additional tourists coming to town. The ambulance is busier and busier and harder to staff, which is creating a reduced response time. She projected a budget estimating \$100,000.00 a year for just the ambulance. Klinger did not bring in any supporting documentation. The City Council was willing to help if our budget allowed it but needed more information. Looking at the income in the General Fund and the possible reduction of \$6,800.00 for help with the 911 services, would have to be investigated further.

FY21-2022 BUDGET:

The City Council went through each line item in each fund. Discussed the potential shared employee again, discussed whether a medical policy or an HSA would work better. Decided to reduce wages for the Community Building.
