CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Botti called the meeting to order @ 9:03 a.m.

FY21-2022 BUDGET:

There will be one more budget meeting after this meeting to finalize the numbers from the House Bill 389 and any other changes. We do need to decide in this meeting on the City Council and Mayor salaries after the task force reported to us in the July 08, 2021, council meeting. Council President Gadwa moves to increase the mayor salary to \$16,000.00 a year and Councilmember pay up to \$2,400.00 per year. Councilmember Cron seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

The city council proceeded to go through each line item. Mayor Botti commented that the city is having more and more meetings. The city clerk suggested that they hire a deputy clerk in the summer months to help with smaller tasks. Greg Wallace suggested that we add a line item to streets and roads for community property Inspections of \$10,000 for additional payroll benefits for his department and all his administrative work, he will no longer pull any hours from administrative leaving enough pay to hire a deputy clerk without having to increase the administrative budget. We also added wages in the Community Building and Park & Recreation in anticipation of Greg hiring another maintenance employee. It was discussed that sometime in the future it would be nice to hire a grant writer.
