MAYOR COMMENTS:

We have received the final floodplain maps from the Army Corp of Engineers (we need to produce an overlay map for the land use map in the comprehensive plan), they have produced a base flood elevation map of the tributaries of Valley Creek and the Salmon River (previously they did this for Valley Creek only). There is a 100-year floodplain and a 500-year floodplain and then the floodway. The next step is to take the maps to the State of Idaho, they will send them to FEMA to receive the flood insurance rate maps, then we will update the land use map, finally we will update the zoning ordinance to rezone Valley Creek Preserve and change the zoning to the open space district.

Sewer Lagoon: We did determine and received documentation via the forest service from DEQ that everything was done correctly when the Sewer Lagoon was abandoned, the sludge was tested so the area is safe for use according to the documentation we received. We are still looking into the possibility of using the old water source (from the 1930's) that was report in the January 16, 2020, council meeting.

CITY CLERK REPORT:


The City Clerk asked the council if there were any questions on the financials, which there were not.
