**2017 SCHEDULE FOR STREET DANCES:** the Summer Street Dance series was presented to the Council in the March 9, 2017, Council Meeting, at which time, the council requested a street dance schedule. The Street Dance schedule is being presented to the City Council today. Councilmember Gadwa moves to approve the 2017 Stanley Summer Street Dance Series MOU. Councilmember Wilson seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

**DONATION BY CUSTER TELEPHONE COOPERATIVE INC.:** CTCI has made a donation to the City of Stanley for the Sled Dog Race, our Sled Dog Race was cancelled and now they would like to donate the funds to another City event. Councilmember Gadwa makes a motion to donate the funds to the A.J. Silva Kite Festival in June. Councilmember Wilson seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

**MAINTENANCE POSITION – HIRING AN ADDITIONAL EMPLOYEE FOR SUMMER:** the old maintenance employee has turned in his keys to Councilmember Lem Sentz. Greg Wallace is interested in returning to the City of Stanley as a maintenance employee, and plans on submitting an application today. It was furthered discussed that we still need an additional maintenance employee, as a part-time employee, all Councilmembers agreed, and authorized the City Clerk to run an ad for an additional maintenance employee.

**ECLIPSE PLANNING:**

1. Community Building Parking Lot – use for command post parking and staging area.
2. Fire Department - use of the Training Center and possible parking spots?
3. Piva Ranch – Dave Boren – is this a possibility?
4. No parking on Airport Road – School parking lot is this a possibility?
5. No parking or camping at the park, no private event rentals, no sporting events, possible shuttle service to the park, enforcement of traffic to the park.
6. Possible assigned areas for day viewing.
7. City of Stanley map to show where parking is permitted, to include RV parking and trailer parking, possible time allotment?
8. Map will be supplied by the Forest Service showing assigned camping areas.
9. Port-a-pots and dumpsters - City Clerk is approved to order 5 additional port-a-pots and two dumpsters.
10. Personnel for traffic control in town, ITD permit is required; possibly informational volunteers only.
11. Vendors for Food - catering permit is required.



- 13. Vendor locations, vendor fees for park location – park rental agreement is required – a vendor will be allowed in the park.


