MAYOR COMMENTS:

Purpose of this meeting for the COVID-19 Emergency Meeting, is to consider 3 items:

1. A Resolution to extend Local Disaster Emergency Declaration that Mayor Botti issued on 3-20-20 which was in effect for seven days. The Resolution will extend it for another 30 days from today. By doing this we are now in line with the County, State and Federal Government and this makes us eligible for all emergency assistance offered.
2. Emergency Powers Ordinance to be added to the city code to allow the Mayor to issue public health emergency orders as needed during COVID-19.
3. Public Health Emergency Order – social distancing

Yesterday Eastern Idaho Health District 7 reported the first confirmed case in Custer County.

Amy Klinger: testing has been available for about a week now in Stanley. Just remember testing results are delayed and we need to continue our compliance with the stay at home orders. If we act now maybe we can save our summer season. If you are mildly sick stay home, if your symptoms become worse with shortness of breath call the Salmon River Clinic to be evaluated. Social distancing and staying home are very important.


