City of Stanley Directory Sign: Councilmember Gadwa moves to approve the new directory signs. Councilmember Wilson seconds. All approve. Motion passes.


Idaho Community Development Block Grant Program: It is too late to apply for the block grant program this year; the City would like to apply for the grant next year. Council President Botti presented a handout explaining that we would be interested in applying for public infrastructure or public parks. Matching funds are required, the higher the match, the greater our chances are of obtaining a grant. It was discussed that we would like to hire an agency to apply for the grant in our behalf and also do an income survey of the workforce to demonstrate that Stanley workforce would consist of 51% or more of low to moderate income, which is a requirement. This is a lengthy process and we should get started fairly soon, in the meantime, the council feels it would be beneficial to hire an additional part-time employee to help process the workforce housing surveys that we have received to date.

Budget 2017-2018: The City Council went through each line item for this preliminary work session, some of the highlighted items were:


1. Ice Rink in Pioneer Park
