CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Botti at 10:07 a.m.

UPCOMING OPTION TAX ORDINANCE TO BE VOTED ON IN NOVEMBER 2020: this is a discussion session only. There is no new proposed ordinance yet. Botti sent out some discussion points.

The following items are being considered and were discussed by the City Council:

- Support for workforce housing built on city-owned property that is owned and managed by the city, including costs for consulting, design, contracting, construction, maintenance, and supervision.
- Operation of the Central Idaho Dark Sky Reserve.
- Valley Creek Preserve
- Water, sewer systems and infrastructure to support Workforce Housing
- Recycling program and additional trash receptacles


The Council also discussed whether or not the river outfitters would continue to be exempt from the option tax. It was decided that some of the councilmembers would approach and discuss this with the river outfitters to see how they feel about the option tax being part of their packages. The outfitters are benefitting from the option tax benefits in town and we would like to see how they feel about this.

Should the duration of the option tax ordinance be longer than 5 years. It was suggested that the new ordinance will be in place for 15 years.

The City Council set up a tentative work session to continue this discussion on July 7, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.


ADJOURNMENT:
