PUBLIC HEARING – Proposed Department of Commerce for an Idaho Community Development Block Grant ICDBG for \$225,000.00:

The Public Hearing was opened At 10:01 a.m. to receive comments on the proposed community Development Block Grant for making improvements to the Stanley Pioneer Park infrastructure.

Kristine Staten with the Development Company is one of the districts the state created to supply economic development help to cities and counties in Eastern Idaho for infrastructure projects. Just recently the State of Idaho implemented a block grant for park projects. One of the goals of these grants is to help cities to become ADA compliant and upgrade to ADA standards. Pioneer Park priorities: Event center, connector trail, ADA year around restrooms, ADA parking areas, sewer line to restrooms, ice arena, summer event center and an amphitheater. A recent survey done by Councilmember Cardoso was supplied to Kristine Staten; it is nice to hear from citizens, the park is for them.

Neutral Testimony: Sari O'Malley, chairman of the board of the Sawtooth Valley Meditation Chapel. She is hoping the park well will be a consideration in the park grant. O'Malley is concerned since the well also supplies water to the Chapel via a contract with the City of Stanley.
