CONSENT AGENDA:

June 14, 2018 Work Session and June 26, 2018 Work Session. Payment approval Report – unpaid and prepaid bills for July/August. Council President Gadwa moves to approve the consent agenda. Councilmember Sentsz seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

LAW ENFORCEMENT:

There was not a detailed report submitted to the City showing the activity for the month of July. We did receive a disposition report for 8/3/2018. The City Council acknowledges the report. Mayor Botti gave Ron Pumphrey a chance to report to the council, he had no comments.

COMMUNITY BUILDING:

The Sawtooth Interpretive and Historical Association would like to request use of the community building on August 10, 2018 from 4-6:30 with all fees waived. They are hosting Janie Weltcamp, a raptor rehabilitator to do a forum and lecture with live birds. Councilmember Wilson moves to approves SIHA use of community building with all fees waived. Council President Gadwa abstains. Councilmember Sentsz seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

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PIONEER PARK:

August 15, 2018 Ground breaking ceremony for the Stanley Redfish Trail has been cancelled. There has been a disagreement with the Forest Service and the land owner on the stipulations of the easement.

OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS:

To discuss proposed changes to the parking ordinance and property access: Mayor Botti wrote out three suggestions the first one is in code 10.08.015 Parking Prohibitions: Need to expand this section to include requirements to park according to posted signage, and in conformance with the requirements of 10.08.020. The second one is in 10.08.020: by resolution, the city council may adopt a parking and traffic plan to designate the manner of public parking on city streets, including parking areas, the direction of parking (parallel or perpendicular), temporary loading and unloading zones, prohibitions of parking in designated areas and in manners that obstruct traffic (pedestrian and bicycle right of way, alleys, loading and unloading zones, etc.), on all city street right of ways. The third one would be a new title (title 11): by ordinance the City of Stanley should adopt the Idaho Standards for Public Work Construction as revised, and by resolution supplemental design and engineering standards that address such things as drainage on city streets, driveway width (the typical standard is 10-12 feet for a single car driveway and 20-24 feet for a double car driveway, or just a minimum and maximum width), driveway angle, number of driveways per length of street frontage (typical is one driveway per 200 feet of frontage), and location to avoid undue obstruction of normal roadway and pedestrian traffic.


Once again, Botti would like to see us adopt the Idaho Standards for Public Work Construction (by Ordinance), with revisions made for the City of Stanley. This is recommended by our engineering firm and our city attorney to establish a base line (we also discussed this in our June 24, 2018 meeting).

Requested to schedule a new Budget Hearing date for FY2018-19 budget. Council President Gadwa moves to schedule a new Budget Hearing date for August 30, 2018 @ 10:00 a.m. Councilmember Wilson seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

ADJOURNMENT:


Mayor Botti adjourns the meeting at 6:34 p.m.
