

**SAWTOOTH MUSIC FESTIVAL:**

The Sawtooth Music Festival Organizers presented the history of the festival and their involvement with it, including the 2012 Event Management Plan and the challenges they faced this year. They recognize that the festival comes with some inconveniences for the community, but stress their belief that the benefits to the community outweigh the inconveniences. The Mayor presents the issues that the community has raised with regard to the festival. The council and community members share a variety of points of view. The major areas of contention seem to be with regard to tax collection, and issues relating to event camping. The City of Stanley is developing a contract for events at the park, and will share it with the SMF organizers. It is unclear at this point whether the event will continue in the future.
